



Hello all WWS anglers:

I am reaching out to all of you to address a problem that we had at our 3rd tournament held on June 25th, 2023. Our Fish Master was calling fish alive or dead using the DNR release guidelines (*Any fish that cannot maintain itself in the water should not be returned to the lake and should be considered a lost fish.*)

That is not how our rules are written for the W.W.S. They state a (*Dead fish will consist of no gill or fin movement*). Because of this error on our part, we will be awarding the field credit for all fish alive. This changes the standings and the payout. As this is the tournament's error, we will not take any money away from any team, we will be pay the difference in the prize money for the top 16 places as required. Places 17-26 will be left as they were awarded as they carry a very similar dollar amount. Again, all teams will receive credit for live fish for the third tournament on June 25th, 2023. We will be changing the postings online. The changes did not affect the NTC side pot standings, so no changes are necessary. We apologize for the mistake and will make adjustments as we move into our championship tournament on July 16th.
